The school has rooms for families with children, young people and the elderly. Good beds and plenty of space! There is a dining room, a lounge and a meeting room. Outdoors there are football and volleyball courts, a campfire hut, bathing jetty, playground and much more.

Meals take place in the dining room, where our chef has cooked for us.

With Vejle Fjord as a neighbor, there are plenty of opportunities for walks by the school, morning and evening swimming and trips to the public beach.

Arrival Sunday from 15.00.

Worship service at 16.00. Then the accommodation.

We eat our own food at 18.00 and say WELCOME to each other at 19.30, where there is an introduction to all the good things we will be together for the next few days. Then we are well on our way.

A joint **breakfast** every day from 8.00 a.m. At 9.15 a.m. there is a flag hoisting and a morning song.

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday we will gather for joint morning devotional at 9.30 a.m. At 10-12 there will be meetings for children and adults with instruction based on the Bible.

In the afternoon, there is the opportunity to go to the water with swimming and playing with football and volleyball. Two seminars are offered with presentations and conversations.

Evening: Sunday welcome evening. Monday and Wednesday meeting evening with singing and sermon. Tuesday social evening.
